A few conditions to apply:

- Projects need to be pre-judged by National Associations and, by preference, be finalists of the national awards.
- They have to be implemented for at least 80% and of a recent date.
- · They need to be written in English and must not exceed 25 A4 pages.
- · They should be in a pdf, Word or PowerPoint format.
- Applications can only be entered by ELA Member Associations, and not directly by companies.

Additional electronic media such as videos or presentations will not be considered and should not be included in the PDF file.

By submitting a project, the nominee gives permission for the work to be published and for the use of the paper and its content by ELA (you can also find the general conditions for the ELA Award on the website: www.elalog.org)

Please, make sure that all application forms, together with candidates' projects will be submitted no later than the 10th December 2010.
